

Description:

The Faculty Development Program (FDP) on "Developing a Robust Internal Quality Assurance System (IQAC)," organized by the IQAC Cell at Invertis University from March 25th to 31st, 2019, aimed to empower faculty members and stakeholders with the knowledge and tools necessary to establish and sustain an effective Internal Quality Assurance System (IQAC). This seven-day program featured a series of interactive sessions, workshops, and hands-on exercises that enriched participants' understanding of quality assurance in higher education. Attendees left the FDP with enhanced proficiency in IQAC development, a commitment to fostering a culture of continuous quality improvement, and valuable networking opportunities for future collaboration.

The FDP commenced with an inaugural address emphasizing the importance of quality assurance in higher education. Over the course of seven days, participants engaged in a series of enlightening sessions and workshops that covered various aspects of IQAC development, including policy formulation, data collection and analysis, and accreditation processes. Interactive discussions allowed participants to share their experiences, challenges, and best practices in quality assurance.

A total of 130 participants benefited from this event. The list of programs included in this event was inaugural session, talks by guest speakers, Q&A session summarization, concluding remarks, valedictory session, and vote of thanks. At the end of the program the convener has taken the feedback from the participants and the key takeaways from the feedbacks are: Participants reported a significant increase in their understanding of IQAC and its role in maintaining educational quality, Faculty members acquired practical skills for drafting IQAC policies and action plans, which they could apply within their respective departments, The FDP instilled a culture of continuous quality improvement, motivating participants to actively engage in quality assurance initiatives.
